


Stevens Creek Cub Scout Day Camp 2005

Dear Scouts and Families,

Get ready for a week of fun adventures at Stevens Creek Day Camp! We're looking forward to you joining us in the deepest, darkest jungles as we go "Swingin into Scouting".

Activities offered at this camp are:

- *BB gun shooting and gun safety instruction (earn BB belt loop)
- *Archery shooting and safety instruction (earn archery belt loop)
- *Scout skills: Earn Scout advancements i.e. flag ceremonies, first aid kits
- *Crafts: lots of jungle themes this year
- *Nature fun: Learn about plants, birds and insects.
- *Sports fun: Last year's obstacle course was awesome and we hoping to add more to this year's course.

Location Stevens Creek Park

DIRECTIONS: To reach Stevens Creek Park, take Interstate 280 to Foothill Expwy. Take Foothill Blvd. south three miles to the park entrance on the left. (Foothill Blvd. changes its name to Stevens Canyon Rd. as it crosses McClellan Rd.) Once inside the park, take the second left into the Villa Maria picnic area. Look for our signs.

Registration Requirements

Every scout registered for these camps must provide a minimum of one (1) adult to work at camp for at least 2 days, depending on camp week.

Packs that want to guarantee spots at camp can do so by "hosting" a camp station for a week or providing a volunteer for a camp director spot. We recommend that you "host" a station to insure your first choice for camp. Contact the camp directors today! One camp is already fully hosted and full as of February 2005.

CAMP UNIFORM

The boys and adults working as staff or den leaders will be issued a T-shirt the first day, which they will change into then, and wear each day of the camp.

ARCHERY AND BB GUNS

Scouts will be transported by car one mile to the archery and BB gun ranges at the Sunnyvale Rod and Gun Club. Den leaders/Parents will help transport the boys to the range. Please have insurance and driving details available when you register with your pack.
